Lighting of the Advent Wreath

The four Advent candles are lit before the service begins.

Speaker 1: The season for watching and waiting is over. The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light. This is the light of the world, and the darkness cannot extinguish it.

The Christ candle is lit.

.Speaker 2: "O sing to the Lord a new song;
Sing to the Lord, all the earth.
Tell of his salvation from day to day.

"Declare his glory among the nations,
His marvelous works among all the peoples" (Psalm 96:1-3).

All four Advent candles are lit.

Speaker 3: "Ascribe to the Lord, O families of the peoples,
Ascribe to the Lord glory and strength.
Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name;
Bring an offering, and come into his courts.
Worship the Lord in holy splendor;
Tremble before him, all the earth" (Psalm 96:7-9).


