If you pay attention to the parsonage flower boxes there is a standard flower that we plant every year around this time. We enjoy the color of marigolds as well as how they keep most bugs away. But the choice is also an homage to Sara's home town of Pekin Illinois which hosts the Marigold festival every year. And for those of you thinking that it might seem really nice to see a town filled with marigolds stop. The festival is a way to honor Everett Dirksen one of the most well-known townspeople. Senator Dirksen tried many years ago to make the marigold our national floral emblem.

This year I did something different. Some years back the NY-DOT cut down a dying/diseased maple that was in the side yard right by the Main St bridge. Now that stump sat for quite a while and I have spent quite a bit of thought trying to figure out what to do with it. Grind it, chop it out, just leave it to eventually rot, all were considered options. Finally late last summer and fall the moles pushed me to make a decision. And no, I did not fence in the area and let the dogs be dogs.

The reality was that barring a large expenditure of funds or dramatically upsetting the kids the stump would remain. Until my memory reminded me of a tree that I had driven past for 20+ years of my young life. You see when the branches had rotted on the tree the homeowner had them taken down. But left them in such a way that a face was painted on the middle one and the others extended as if in praise. Once those too rotted it was turned into a more traditional stump only it stood about five feet tall. Then the top was hollowed out and flower placed at the top. Over the next few years the stump got about a foot shorter ever two or three years. Until finally the whole remnant was turned to grass.



A young boy had seen a tree with rotting branches, while a home-owner had seen a canvas. An older boy saw a really big stump and that same home-owner saw a planter. The stump in the parsonage lawn, is not filled with dirt and marigolds.

It's easy to look at ourselves and only see ourselves one way. But we need to understand and embrace the reality that God sees us in a far different way and with so much more potential than we do. Humanity, we see fishermen out on an inland sea. Jesus sees the founding building blocks of what will become his church. He sees tax collectors and sinners with different eyes than the rest of the world. He sees not who we are but the people that he has and will call us to be. And he sees us in the fullest of our potential.

All of us like so many throughout history and scripture struggle with the vision of ourselves that God sees. We struggle to see and be seen for what God has done and is doing in and through us. Ask any minister how the church they grew up in saw them for the first 20+ years of their ministry and they will likely relate a story of how they were always to that congregation the child sitting down for the children's message.

The challenge for each of us is to see both ourselves and others as much more than the canvas we had seen and know, but as the beautiful work of art that God has in mind for each of us. We might see ourselves as just a stump, but take a moment and imagine all that God sees us to be.


